- Objective: To instill a sense of responsibility and love for one’s country by reflecting on Shivaji Maharaj’s dedication to the welfare of his kingdom and his people.

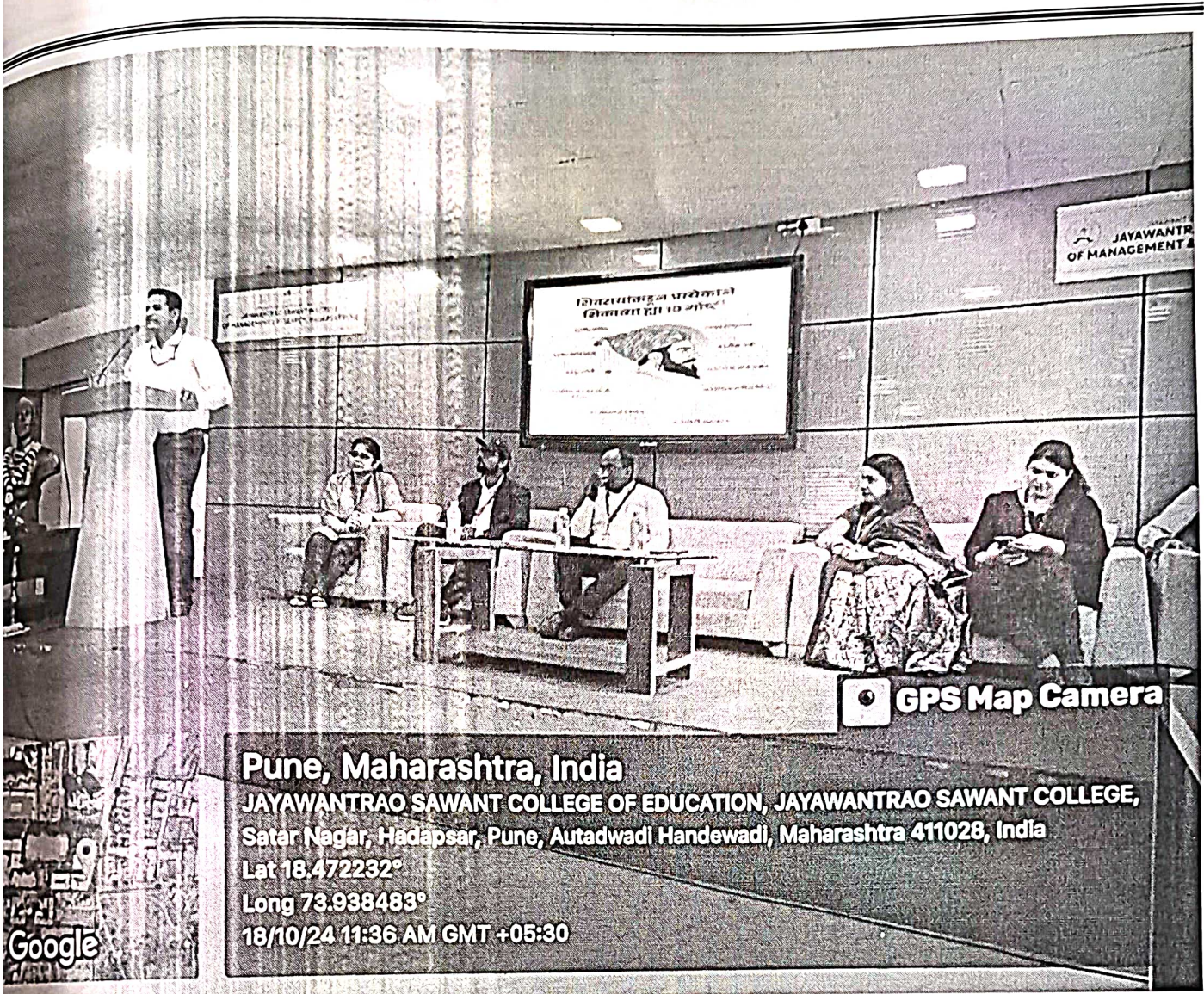
