



Item 1: Welcome address and introductory speech by Dr. R. D. Kanphade, Principal and Chairperson IQAC:

The IQAC Chairperson Dr R.D. Kanphade welcomed all members present for the meeting. All Departmental coordinators are instructed to start NAAC revisit as it will schedule in the month of November. Dr. Kanphade has taken review of work for NAAC through all HODs. Chairman also instructed the IQAC coordinator to apply for IIQA and completion of all reports regarding NAAC. He appreciated the efforts of all faculty members during the NAAC visit.

Item 2: Confirmation of last minutes of meeting and status of action taken report

Item 3: Road map to implement NEP

The IQAC Coordinator, Dr. C. Manjare, informed the committee that the institute has begun implementing the National Education Policy (NEP) and emphasized the need to establish a roadmap that incorporates all its elements. Students across departments have started registering for academic bank credits. Faculty members and Heads of Departments (HODs) are encouraged to participate in NEP workshops. At least two faculty members from each department have attended both online and offline workshops organized by the institute locally. HOD Mechanical Dr. P. A. Patil has taken a workshop on NEP in March 2023.

Item 4. Training for newly joined faculties:

The IQAC Coordinator highlighted the need to train recently joined faculty members on academic processes. Dr. Shailesh Hambarde, the Academic Dean, presented the results of an internal audit conducted within departments by the AMC and module coordinators. Chairman instructed that a session be arranged with AQAR member Dr. Suneets Phadkule for all new faculties. Department coordinators carefully reviewed department-level data for various activities. Quality enhancement coordinators summarized faculty feedback gathered within departments and shared the report with IQAC.

The committee reviewed the department's result analysis and congratulated the faculty for achieving nearly 100 percent results. The Campus Director encouraged faculty to focus on enhancing students' practical knowledge through various skill-building activities.
